

Remembrance Day

1. Reference: General Order #4, Series 2020-2021, 13 November 2020, *Remembrance Day*.
2. November 19th, the anniversary of the Gettysburg Address and the Dedication of the Gettysburg National Cemetery, was formally designated as *Dedication Day*, by a joint resolution of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives, on November 19, 1946. This date has been remembered by the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War as *Veterans' Night* and is today known as *Remembrance Day*.
3. Per para. 4., of the referenced General Order #4:

Therefore, on this Remembrance Day, Saturday, 21 November 2020, each Department and Camp is urged to conduct or participate in an appropriate patriotic service as its particular circumstances permit, being mindful of the health and welfare of our Brothers, and in accordance with local and state pandemic restrictions or orders.
4. It is therefore ordered that all Camps and Brothers within the Department of the Chesapeake observe the day, Thursday, November 19th, 2020, and are encouraged to share their efforts with the Department and National Offices of the Order in accordance with the cited reference.
5. To paraphrase General Logan's Memorial Day Order, "In this observance no form of ceremony is prescribed, but Camps and Brothers will in their own way arrange such fitting services and testimonials of respect as circumstances may permit."
