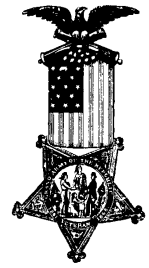

Section 3.02. These three Camps may have their Charters restored upon individually filing SUVCW Forms 22, 27, providing proof of filing an EIN report for 2014, and paying all outstanding per capita dues for their enrolled members by, and not later than, noon EST 14 November 2014.

Section 3.03. If the Camps do not comply with section 3.02 above, I will officially recommend to the SUVCW Commander-in-Chief that their Charters be revoked dating from 15 November 2014. Should the SUVCW Commander-in-Chief choose to revoke said Charters, members of those three Camps who remain in good standing with the Department and National Order will be transferred to Harpers Ferry Camp No. 6.
