SUBJECT: Eagle Scout Program

Brother Camp Commanders,

All Department of the Chesapeake Camps should be active in the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War Eagle Scout Program. Rewarding young men and women who achieve Eagle Scout is one of the many goals of our Order. I enthusiastically supports this program and the Department Eagle Scout Certificate Coordinator is committed to helping you.

The purpose of the Eagle Scout Certificate Coordinator is to recognize the advancement of young scouts belonging to the Boy Scouts of America to the rank of Eagle Scout and to maintain statistics of requests and presentations of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War Eagle Scout Certificate. It was not intended for the appointed Brother to pay out of pocket expenses for certificates and mailing costs. This advisory corrects a budget oversight and enhances the quality of packets presented to Eagle Scout recipients.

Effective immediately the Department of the Chesapeake budget will include line item expenses for the purchase of Eagle Scout Program items. These include 3" Eagle Scout patches @ \$2.75, presentation folders @ \$2.75, and certificates @ .50. The Department averages 50 Eagle Scout presentations each year. The annual Department expense will be \$300.00 plus shipping.

All packets for presentation will include Eagle Scout Certificate, Eagle Scout patch, certificate folder, and special congratulatory letters from the Department Commander and Eagle Scout Certificate Coordinator.
