- 1. Any and all expressions of personal opinion **shall not** include the name or any symbols of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War.
- 2. Any and all requests for commentary to be given **on behalf** of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War regarding the Confederate battle flag, monumentation, markers or incidents directly or indirectly related thereto shall be directed to the Department Commander.
- 3. Brothers shall read the current policy regarding the Confederate battle flag as found on the National Policy page on the Order's website: http://www.suvcw.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/08/Battlefield-flag-Policy.pdf Any and all questions emanating therefrom shall be directed to the Department Commander.
